POLICIES

Scent Aware

Christine Morrison is a scent-aware school, as some people are sensitive to strong scents, such as perfumes and body lotions. Please be aware and refrain from sending your child with scented hand sanitizers or lotions.

Dogs

St. John's Ambulance therapy dog Jester will visit Christine Morrison. Jester and his Human, Roy, are no strangers to us; many students love reading with Jester. Feel free to reach out if you have any questions about this program.

Families are reminded that School District Policy prohibits dogs, except service dogs, from being on school grounds at any time. This policy is made for health and safety reasons.

West Coast Recess and Lunch Breaks

It rains frequently in Mission, and our breaks are usually outdoors as fresh air and being outside is beneficial for students' regulation and learning. For safety reasons, students should not bring umbrellas to school but are encouraged to wear rain boots and jackets. Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather.

Pick-up and Drop-offs

These are from the outside doors of the classrooms. Please direct your child. Please use street parking if you need to park and pick up your child. The parking lot is reserved for district and school staff and vehicles with a handicap/disability pass only.

Office Check-ins

If you are coming into the school, please make sure to check in with the front office. This way, we can ensure that our students are safe and know who is in the building in case of emergency.

Things to Note

Lice

It's the time of year when we start to have cases of head lice in the school. We thank you in advance for taking the time to help us control the spread of lice by checking your child regularly and reporting it to us. Balanced Parenting
