Indigenous Veterans Day

"Did you know that November 8th is annually recognized as National Indigenous Veterans Day in Canada?

National Indigenous Veterans Day started in Winnipeg in 1994 to honour all First Nations, Mètis and Inuit soldiers who served in war for Canada.

Prior to 1994, Indigenous soldiers were not permitted to participate in Remembrance Day ceremonies as a group or to lay wreaths. Indigenous veterans were only allowed to attend as an individual.

1994 was the first year that an Indigenous soldier placed a wreath at the Cenotaph in Ottawa. It wasn't until 1995 that Indigenous soldiers were allowed to march as a group or lay a wreath at the Cenotaph in Vancouver." (North Vancouver School District)

PROJECT OF HEART

Project of Heart was founded in 2007 by an Ottawa teacher named Sylvia Smith. She started the movement in response to the lack of information in schools regarding Residential Schools. Now Project of Heart is nation wide and in fact, some of the student reflections from Project of Heart are published in United Nations reports.

One of the goals of the BC Teachers Federation is to make public education itself a vehicle for healing and reconciliation. So the 2012 BCTF collaborated with:

- teachers and students from over 270 schools,
- carver Derrick George and sons (Tsleil-Waututh) and,
- Una Ann Moyer (Tahltan artist)

to create the beautiful Project of Heart canoe. The overwhelming message is reconciliation and healing.

In addition to having the Project of Heart canoe at Christine Morrison for several weeks, a Heart Garden was created by Christine Morrison Elementary students with the message that Every Child Matters.
