Last month, our school held a special assembly to honor the National Day of Truth and Reconciliation and allow students to reflect on its significance.



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# **POLICIES**

#### Scent Aware

Christine Morrison is a scent-aware school, as there are people who are sensitive to strong scents such as perfumes and body lotions. Please be aware and refrain from sending your child with scented hand sanitizers or lotions.

## Dogs

Families are reminded that School District Policy prohibits dogs from being on school grounds at any time, apart from service dogs. This policy is made for health and safety reasons.

#### Halloween

The wearing of a Halloween costume is optional. If your child is planning to wear a costume, all costumes must be school-appropriate:

- No weapons or accessories
- Nothing too scary as we have 4-year-olds in the school.
- New this year no blow-up costumes as it was a safety issue with limited space in the school.
- Please remember that it is a full day of school, and costumes need to be comfortable for the day or able to be removed.

# West Coast Recess and Lunch Breaks

It rains frequently in Mission, and our breaks are usually outdoors as fresh air and being outside is beneficial for students' regulation and learning. For safety reasons, students should not bring umbrellas to school, but they are encouraged to wear rain boots and jackets. Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather.

### Pick-up and Drop-offs

These are from the outside doors of the classrooms. Please direct your child. If you need to park and pick up your child, please use street parking. The parking lot is reserved for district and school staff and vehicles with a handicap/disability pass only.
