Dear Parents/Guardians,

Our first complete week has finished, and it has been wonderful to see so many families and meet our new families as well. The school staff have worked hard to ensure that everything is in place for a terrific year ahead. The children are really doing well working within their learning groups and hopefully, the weather this week will have everyone outside enjoying the beautiful fall weather.



I would like to thank you, our school community, for following our guidelines of physical distancing and ensuring that your children are arriving within the 'soft start' times versus arriving early and being on the playground. We have worked very hard creating two separate schedules for recess/lunch where learning groups are able to enjoy being together safely which includes the use of playgrounds. We have also noted that families who pick up their child between 2:00 and 2:23 are promptly leaving grounds which is greatly appreciated.

As of Monday, September  $28^{th}$ , we are reducing our soft start  $\underline{to 8:30 - 8:45}$  in the morning and  $\underline{2:10}$  for the early dismissal in the afternoon. We have noted that most families are arriving at school by 8:35 or so, and by 8:40 on most days, the students are all in class.

At ECME, we value our partnership with our parent/guardian community. Clear communication and involvement in the school creates a strong partnership. If you wish to meet with your child's teacher or administration, this year we require appointments to made ahead of time versus dropping in as we have always done. Please email your child's teacher directly or the admin you wish to meet with, and a time will be found that is convenient for both schedules. At this time, most meetings will be held over the phone or virtually. Newsletters will be issued during the last week of each month with email updates throughout the year as well. Newsletters will be sent to our families as well as posted on the website.

Living in a rainforest climate, we are all very familiar with the amount of rain we receive throughout the year. At ECME we believe in the importance of having children outside, getting fresh air and playing, for the recess and lunch breaks even in the rain. The students are very accustomed to donning their boots and rain jackets and heading outside. Please ensure that your child has boots and a rain jacket as well as a change of socks if their feet become wet. For safety reasons, students are not to bring umbrellas to school.

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## Thursday, September 30th Orange Shirt Day:

September 30th falls during the time of year when Indigenous children were taken away to residential school.

The "orange shirt" in Orange Shirt Day refers to the new shirt that Phyllis Webstad was given to her by her grandmother for her first day of school at St. Joseph's Mission residential school in British Columbia. When Phyllis got to school, they took away her clothes, including her new shirt. It was never returned. To Phyllis, the colour orange has always reminded her of her experiences at residential school and, as she has said, "how my feelings



didn't matter, how no one cared, and I felt like I was worth nothing. All of us little children were crying, and no one cared." Please see the CBC link for more information:
